## *Making the most of your wedding morning*

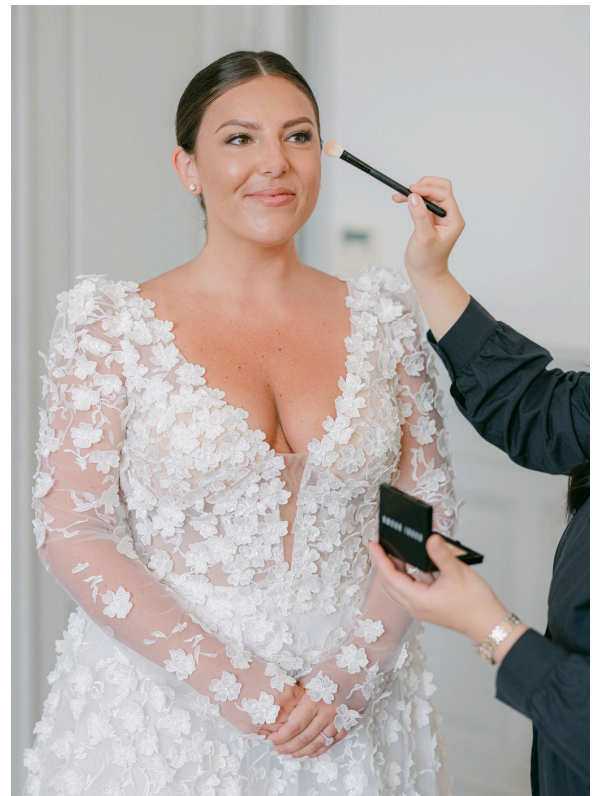
Your wedding morning is your time to relax and be pampered, and limiting distractions not only helps your artist do her job, but maximizes your experience as well. Here are few tips to help you make the most of your morning:

- Stay Hydrated: Drink plenty of water throughout the days leading up to your wedding and on the big day itself. Staying hydrated helps keep your skin glowing and your energy levels up.
- Delegate: Designate someone you trust to handle any unexpected issues or last-minute details, so you can focus on enjoying the day. Also, make sure to have all your wedding items (ring, stationery, vows, shoes, veil...) are prepared for your photographer before starting the makeup so you don't have to leave your beauty chair during the service. Even a 20 minute delay can have a big impact on the rest of the timeline.
- Set up: Please ensure that a suitable empty and large table and a chair are provided with consideration to height, space and natural light and remove any items on the table prior to my arrival so I can start setting my kit right away. Please note that each beauty artist needs one table and one chair.
- Enjoy the moment: Your beauty session is the perfect time to unwind and let your artist work their magic. To ensure everything runs smoothly and stays on schedule, try to avoid distractions like cell phone use, or eating during makeup application. These distractions can make the artist's job more challenging, lead to unnecessary delays, and compromise the quality of the final look. Instead, take this moment to breathe, have fun with your bridal party and enjoy the pampering, and trust that you're in expert hands, it's your time to shine!

## O2.

### *How to prepare for your makeup session*

- Makeup inspiration pictures: My brides want to look like the best version of themselves: polished, radiant, and naturally enhanced. If you're more inclined towards a natural look, I recommend selecting soft makeup inspiration over a full glam style to achieve that effortless bridal glow.
- For the bridal beauty preview: Please wear a white top or dress. This will help you better visualize how your makeup and hair will complement your bridal gown.
- Skincare: To ensure the best outcome, avoid introducing any new skincare products into your routine at least two weeks before your beauty session.
- Arrive with clean face: Please arrive with your face already cleansed. You may apply your daily serum, moisturizer, and SPF beforehand. If you have any skin allergies, kindly inform me before the beauty session. Makeup application may be declined if any contagious skin or eye conditions are present.
- Lash: Please avoid getting lash extensions or a lash lift before your session, as these can make eye makeup application more challenging. The shimmery eyeshadows may get stuck between the lashes, resulting in a messy finish. Lashes are included in my service, so you don't need to worry about this!
- Eyebrows: To avoid redness or irritation, please refrain from waxing your eyebrows within three days of the session.

## *How to prepare for your hairstyling*

- Hair inspiration pictures: The same hairstyle can look different depending on hair color, length, and texture. For the best results, try to choose inspiration photos that reflect hair similar to yours in color, texture, and length. While the exact look might not be perfectly replicated, having photos of similar hair will help me better understand your vision, aesthetic, and overall vibe.
- Arrive with clean and dry hair: For the best results, please ensure your hair is washed with shampoo and conditioner and completely blow-dried the night before your beauty session. Hair should be clean, dry, and thoroughly detangled before my arrival, as hairstyling is done on dry hair only. If you have curly hair and desire a smooth style, please blow-dry and smooth it out beforehand. Additional blow-drying on the day of the wedding may significantly delay the schedule. Please note that a fee of €50 per person will apply if I need to blow-dry wet hair prior to styling.



- Hair extensions: If your hair doesn't hold curls well or if you have fine hair, I highly recommend adding clip-in hair extensions. They'll provide the volume, thickness, and body needed for styles like Hollywood waves, half up half down, or a ponytail.

For the best quality and comfort, I always recommend my brides purchase their extensions from Luxy Hair and opt for the Seamless Clip-In Hair Extensions for an effortless and comfortable fit.

## *Your beauty calendar: Prepare to glow on your big day*

### **Skincare preparation**

#### 6-12 Months before the wedding:

- Establish a skincare routine: Cleanse, exfoliate, moisturize, and apply sunscreen daily.
- Consult a professional: Visit a dermatologist or esthetician for personalized treatments.
- Exfoliation: Start gentle exfoliation to remove dead skin cells and improve glow.

#### 1-3 Months Before the wedding:

- Facials: Schedule your final professional facial at least two weeks before the wedding.
- Tackle specific issues: Focus on any acne, hyperpigmentation, or sensitivity concerns.
- Avoid new products on your skin to avoid irritation and redness.

The week before: Gentle exfoliation: Use a mild exfoliant 2-3 days before the wedding for smooth makeup application.

### **Hair care preparation**

#### 3-6 Months Before the Wedding

- Healthy trims: Schedule regular trims to keep hair looking healthy.
- Deep conditioning treatments: Incorporate treatments or masks weekly to improve moisture and strength.
- Hair trial: Schedule your bridal hair trial to finalize your look.

The Week Before: Touch up your color: Ensure highlights, balayage, or root touch-ups are done a week before.
